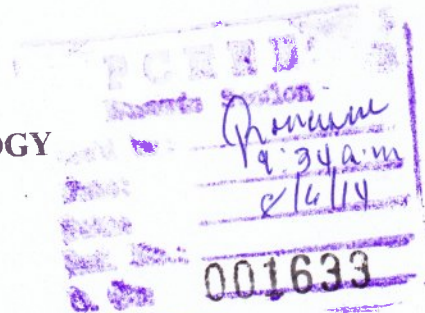

## **Speaker Biographical Information**

### **Dr. Bruce E. Gnade, Vice President for Research, University of Texas, Dallas**

Bruce Gnade is the Vice President for Research and the Distinguished Chair in Microelectronics at the University of Texas at Dallas. He received his BA in Chemistry from St. Louis University in 1976 and his Ph.D. in Nuclear Chemistry from the Georgia Institute of Technology in 1982. He managed several research and technology groups during his 14 years at Texas Instruments. From 1996-1999 he was a Program Manager at the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA). His current research areas focus on electronic materials, primarily flexible electronics and thermoelectric materials. He has authored/co-authored approximately 130 refereed journal papers, 70 U.S. patents, and 55 foreign patents.

### **Dr. Charles Dunlap, Associate Program Director, CRDF Global**

Dr. Dunlap has worked for over a decade directing international development and university programs in the sciences and conducting research in environmental geochemistry. Since 2004 he has worked with CRDF Global where he is Associate Program Director responsible for capacity building programs in sixteen countries throughout Eurasia, the Middle East, and Africa. He has overseen the development of four non-governmental science foundations and provided training and support to three science and innovation funding agencies. He has also overseen the development and implementation of national virtual science libraries in eight countries and taught short courses in proposal writing for graduate students at the University of Vermont and faculty at Texas Tech University. He developed the curriculum for professional skills workshops on the topics of research management, peer-reviewed publication, research ethics, proposal development, and merit-review process, and he has led trainings for more than 3,000 scientists and engineers in fourteen countries.

### **Cristina Atencio, Associate Program Manager, CRDF Global.**

Cristina Atencio has organized 39 workshops for more than 2,570 scientists and engineers in 11 countries covering strategies for success in proposal writing, research paper authorship, implementing peer-reviewed grant competitions, international conference participation, and research ethics. She has developed and leads training on workshop modules covering plagiarism, Mendeley, and ResearchGate. She received B.A. degrees in Political Science and French from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill and prior to working with CRDF Global managed international programs with the League of Women Voters, including implementing grant competitions, planning and leading international delegations, organizing a 12-country conference, and developing and leading trainings. In addition to her work on professional skills development courses, she plans and coordinates the annual International Funding Agency Symposium (IFAS) with the U.S. National Science Foundation and oversees national virtual science library programs in Morocco, Algeria, and Afghanistan. She is responsible for technical development of Virtual Science Library portals in eight countries and is fluent in Spanish and highly proficient in French.
